A16 | Awaken to God's Presence | Lectio Divina Prophetic Voice Project Zion Podcast

Hi this is Tyler Marz, Community of Christ minister and spiritual companion. Part of my journey is finding the divine in everyday life. Today I invite you to join me in a Lectio Divina as we explore our prophetic voice as prophetic people in Doctrine and Covenants 162: 8a.

As a prophetic people and prophetic individuals, we recognize our own inherent worth and truth that lies within. It is this truth that guides our actions both as individuals, and in community.

Today we are going to engage in a brief practice of lectio divina, where we reflect on a brief passage of scripture, and I ask a few questions for you to silently reflect on.

As we begin, I invite you as you are able to close your eyes and take a few deep breaths.

As I read the scripture, let the words sink deep.

As I ask questions, let your mind ponder them.

What do you see, hear, or discern as truth within? Give yourself permission to trust that inner voice.
