Greetings, sojourners. My name is Wendy Brian. I'm a minister, spiritual director and spiritual formation specialist in Community of Christ. It is good to be with you today. In Community of Christ, we have nine enduring principles that guide our lives, our ministry and our stories. These nine principles are: all are called, worth of all persons, responsible choices, pursuit of peace (shalom), unity in diversity, blessings of community, grace and generosity, continuing revelation and sacredness of creation. Today, I offer you a meditation on the worth of all persons. As we begin, please know that silence and meditation is a gift, it is a chance to listen. From time to time in this process today, there will be silent moments. Let them speak to your heart. You may want some paper and something to write with as you move through this time with the divine today. In Community of Christ, we love to sing. Our hymnal, Community of Christ Sings reflects our theology and traditions. Today, we will take one of these hymns, which is number 636, known as "I Have Called You by Your Name," and pause between each line and sit with the meaning of what is being said. You will hear another voice read the line. Then you will hear some reflective questions on those words. Feel free to pause as needed to give time to Dig. Dig deep into your soul for what these words say to you, and how they can enrich your relationship with the Holy One. Now, find a comfortable spot in your body. We will take three deep cleansing breaths to center ourselves in this moment. Deep breath in ... and out. In ... and out. In ... and out.

What name do you hear when you are called by God? Is that the name you were given at birth? Or another name? Is that a word or phrase that has meaning to you? Rather than your given name, can

I have gifted you and ask you now to shine.

Where is your giftedness? Perhaps you feel void of giftedness. Yet you continue to search for it. Don't be afraid to explore new things, new paths. When you find it or if you've already found it, share it freely. It can be God's expression through you

I will not abandon you. All my promises are true.

Do you ever feel abandoned? If you do, what brings you back? In the darkness it's sometimes difficult to remember God's promises to us. Where do you go in those times?

God claims you for God's self. Own that claim. Feel that claim. Live that claim.

Offer Jesus's body given long ago.

Perhaps you experience God's love and worth through the sacrament of communion or as some call it the Lord's Supper. You are worthy to partake of this sacrament no matter who you are, where you are, or how you live. If you haven't experienced the sacrament in a while, I invite you to find a place where it is offered to you and participate in its remembrance.
